The Economic Cooperation Organization seeks to recruit an International Consultant for the Feasibility Study on the ECO Container and Passenger trains on Istanbul-Tehran-Almaty Route. The Consultant should have a university degree in railway, transit transport, corridor management or transport economics or related subjects. He/she (or the company) should have extensive knowledge and working experience in planning, management or assessment of regional railway corridors.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assess the economic and operational potentials for the ECO Trains;
- Prepare Terms of Reference for National Consultants;
- Analyze the obstacles to the way of regular operation of the Trains;
- Formulate recommendations and a proposed strategy, mechanism of route management, and action plan for regularizing the operation of the above Trains, including proposals for relevant investment projects;
- Visit the enroute Countries and attend the technical negotiations with the concerned railway administrations of the enroute member states;
- Preparing analytical reports and briefings needed by the Secretariat and member States;
- Review and consolidate the reports of the National Consultants.
- Attend the meetings of the national consultants and the concerned railway authorities of the enroute member states;
- Liaising with the national consultants and member states and other relevant international organizations regarding the feasibility study.
